<i>Input Parameters –</i>	Name of the Salary Planner
<i>Extract ID:</i>	Chart of Accounts
<i>COA:</i>	The name of the scenario
<i>Scenario:</i>	Derived from the organization code on NBAPBUD
<i>Organization</i>	Organization code on NBAPBUD
<i>UIN</i>	Employee UIN (University Illinois number)
<i>Name</i>	Employees Last, First MI
<i>Total Proposed FTE</i>	Full Time Employment equivalent value; cannot exceed 1.0
<i>Total Proposed Salary</i>	Annual salary
<i>FTE Adjustment</i>	Total proposed salary/total proposed FTE or is the annualized full-time salary.
<i>Service/FTE Adjustment</i>	Adjustment calculation based on value of Current E-class
<i>Current E-class</i>	Current E-Class on PEAEMPL
<i>New Job E-class</i>	New Position E-Class code
