

Military Leave Executive Order 2003-6 Effective February 7, 2003

Governor Rod Blagojevich issued Executive Order 2003-6 on February 7, 2003. This Order extends the same privileges regarding compensation and benefits to State employees as Executive Order #10 that we have been operating under since September, 2001. Executive Order 2003-6 applies only to employees on active military duty because of **U.S. relations with Iraq**. The University is applying the provisions of both Executive Order #10 and 2003-6 to all full- and part-time employees.

If the call-up is **not** for one of the operations under Executive Order #10 or 2003-6 protection, the employee is entitled to the provisions under Policy 11, Rule 11.04 Military Leave (<https://nessie.uihr.uillinois.edu/pdf/policy/rules/pr11r04.pdf>) or academic military leave policies (https://nessie.uihr.uillinois.edu/cf/policies/index.cfm?Item_id=894) only.
